Located on the stunning west coast of Canada is a wild and remote area of the Pacific Northwest known as Knight Inlet. It is the longest fjord on the BC coast (the second longest in Canada) and offers visitors spectacular scenery set against a backdrop of dramatic mountain peaks plunging into the Pacific Ocean. Kaleidoscopic hues of blues and greens seamlessly blend forest, ocean, and sky. It can be a place of immense silence in the calm of the temperate **Great Bear Rainforest** and of immense power in the face of the many thundering glacier-fed waterfalls.

Situated thirty-two nautical miles (sixty kilometers) from the mouth of the inlet is Knight Inlet Lodge. Our remote floating Lodge is tucked into Glendale Cove deep within the traditional territories of the Da'naxda'xw Awaetlala First Nation and it is here at the Lodge, that you will begin each day's adventure.

The Lodge is an assortment of five modern floats containing eighteen guest rooms, dining room, lounge, interpretive center, saunas and support buildings. All rooms have two queen beds with private washroom and shower (except our family rooms which have one queen and two twin beds). The dining room has ample seating for fifty, plus deck seating that offers panoramic views of Glendale Cove where guests can mingle before and after meals. At full capacity the Lodge will accommodate approximately forty guests. We have found this maximum capacity allows for an optimum wildlife experience for both our guests and our resident population of Grizzly Bears.

Glendale Cove is home to one of the largest concentrations of Grizzly Bears in Canada. It is not uncommon for there to be multiple bears within a ten kilometer radius of the lodge in both the Spring during mating season and the Autumn when the salmon return to spawn. Although the bears are abundant in the fall, it is not the only season that grizzly bears can be found in Glendale Cove. Starting in late April the bears return to the estuary from their winter dens and start the year feeding on the sedges, succulents, grasses, and all sorts of shore-based food sources (barnacles, crabs, etc) that abound in our estuary. This luxuriant spring growth provides the basic nutritional needs for the bears and draws them from the mountains down to the estuary. This is the time tiny cubs emerge with their ever-cautious mothers. In the summer (during our 'Summer Adventure' part of the season), the addition of berry crops keep the bears in the general area around Knight Inlet Lodge.

The season at Knight Inlet Lodge is divided into three sections with different methods of viewing wildlife depending on the time of year. Throughout our season we set out in boats designed to provide our guests exceptional viewing opportunities within Glendale Cove and the estuary. Beginning in late August, in addition to the boat-based viewing we provide viewing opportunities from our elevated viewing stands. The viewing stands are located along the Glendale River which provide chances to view the grizzlies' fishing for salmon. In all our viewing programs our guest safety is of utmost importance, and we strive to view the bears in their natural environment without disturbances.

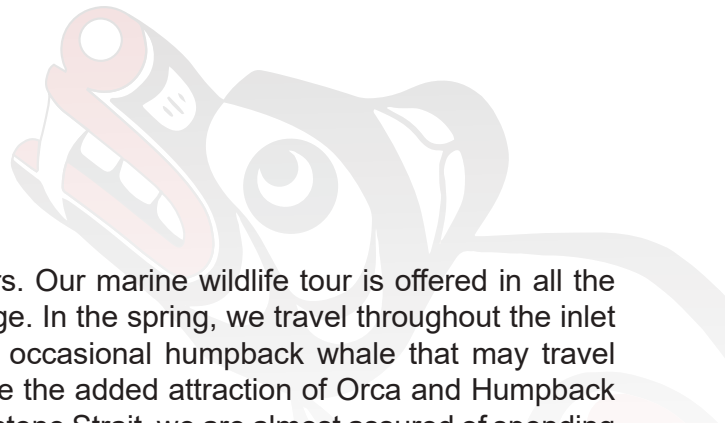

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In addition to our bear viewing, we offer several other tours. Our marine wildlife tour is offered in all the seasons that we operate but it varies as the seasons change. In the spring, we travel throughout the inlet viewing the seals, sea lions, porpoises, dolphins and the occasional humpback whale that may travel through our waters. Beginning in July, our marine tours have the added attraction of Orca and Humpback whale viewing and we journey out to the world-famous Johnstone Strait, we are almost assured of spending some great viewing time with these magnificent marine mammals. We also provide inlet cruise tours, excursions to the upper reaches of Knight Inlet, plus walking and hiking tours in the local area. We have guided kayaking tours in Glendale Cove, these tours are great for the novice as we have double and single kayaks and our guides will take you through a brief lesson and then get you on the water. This is a very popular tour with our guests. There are great photographic opportunities on all tours, whether the viewing is of birds, bears, other wildlife, or scenery.

In today's world, it is important to have the adventure, connection and the stimulus of nature. Our team at Knight Inlet Lodge strives to provide an amazing environment where you can enjoy bear viewing at one of the most pristine, remote, and simply amazing parts of Canada.

Please note that all land-based tours do require, at a minimum, walking distances of approximately 200 meters on rocky and / or uneven shoreline that may be slippery. To take part in these tours you must be able to walk this section without the assistance of Knight Inlet Lodge Guide Staff. The style of wildlife tours we offer are not suitable for guests that require the use of walkers or wheelchairs.

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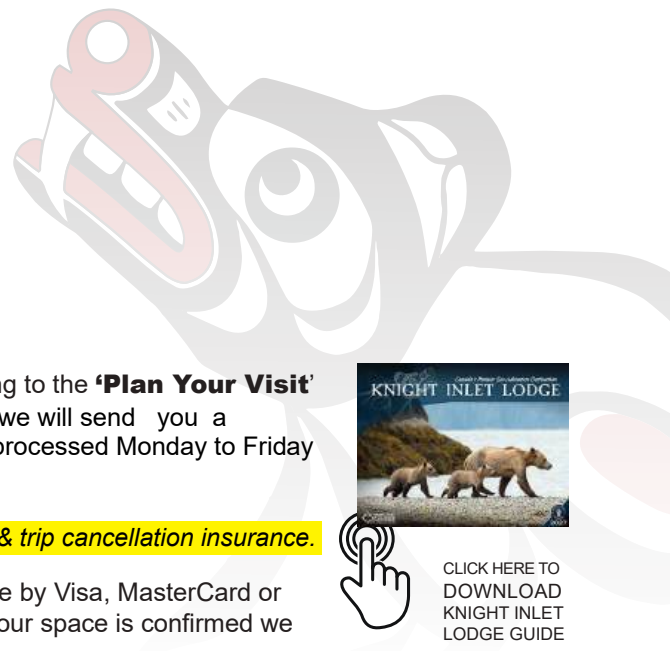

FLOATPLANE OPERATIONS CAN BE INTERRUPTED AT ANYTIME DUE TO UNFORESEEN CIRCUMSTANCES. IN THIS CASE, ALTERNATE LODGE TRANSPORT WILL BE SUBSTITUTED

Departures originate from the Vancouver Island Air Float Plane dock at 2870 Spit Road. Departure and arrival times can vary due to weather conditions so please make sure that you have sufficient connecting time for departure flights following your tour.

IF YOU ARE DRIVING, PAY PARKING IN EFFECT AT THE FLOATPLANE TERMINAL.

LUGGAGE ALLOWANCE : 14kg (30lbs) per person

Any excess baggage could be subject to a service charge or a later arrival if space is limited. For couples two smaller individual bags are better than 1 large bag. Complimentary* secure luggage storage is available. Due to Transport Canada safety protocols, 'Carry-On' luggage is NOT available on this class of aircraft (see "prepare for your visit" link below for more information).

Prior to arriving at Knight Inlet Lodge, all guests are required to sign a **Release of Liability, Waiver of Claims, Assumption of Risk and Indemnity Agreement.** We strongly recommend that all guests review this document prior to making your reservation. Guests will also be required to complete a Health Questionnaire, due to our remote location, knowing of any health issues is particularly important. These two documents will be provided to you upon your arrival in Campbell River the evening prior to your flight into the Lodge.

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FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

► Why do I have to stay the first night in Campbell River?

Due to logistics and Floatplane and/or Boat operations, the coordination and departure is too early in the morning for the guest to arrive on the day of departure to the Lodge. The night in Campbell River is NOT OPTIONAL.

► On my departure day, when do I arrive back in Campbell River?

Typically you will return to the Campbell River floatplane facility by 11:15AM on your Lodge Departure day. We recommend not booking any 'tight' connectors (flights, ferries, etc) as there may be a chance of delays in floatplane operations due to weather and/or ocean conditions and/or other unforeseen conditions.

► What is there for me to do in Campbell River?

Campbell River is an Oceanside city of approximately 30,000 people that has a lot to offer. From an excellent local museum featuring First Nation and Pioneer history to kilometers of paved Oceanside walking trails there is an activity for everyone. Please see the links below.

► Can the I go whale watching while at Knight Inlet Lodge?

Yes, this all day adventure is possible on a KILGB4 or longer package. Please note our whale watching season runs from approximately the middle of July until the end of September and is weather dependent.

► Can I go fishing while at Knight Inlet Lodge?

Due to the the strict Environmental Management Plan now in place at our location in the Protected Great Bear Rainforest, sport fishing is not allowed. We recommend contacting a local day trip provider in Campbell River for either a Pre or Post Lodge stay fishing adventure.

► Is there Wi-Fi / internet at the Lodge?

Sorry but there is no guest internet of any kind at our lodge. There is also no mobile phone coverage. The lodge is a 'Digital detox' zone.

► Do you supply raingear and rubber boots?

Yes, we supply, on a complimentary basis, good quality raingear and rubber boots should you need them. We do recommend bringing hiking / trekking shoes or boots if you have them.

► Is there parking available for self-drive guests while at the lodge?

Yes, there is designated parking for Knight Inlet Lodge guests at both the Comfort Inn and at the floatplane docking facility. **PAY PARKING IN EFFECT AT THE FLOATPLANE TERMINAL.**

► Is there extra storage available for luggage while at the Lodge?

Yes, there is complimentary secure storage at the floatplane facility for Knight Inlet Lodge guests. Floatplane luggage limit is 14Kg (30lbs) per guest. An on-site Knight Inlet Lodge host will assist guests.

► Is it ok to tip the staff?

Tips are not expected, but are always appreciated and should you decide to leave a gratuity, the amount is totally up to you and should reflect your level of satisfaction.
